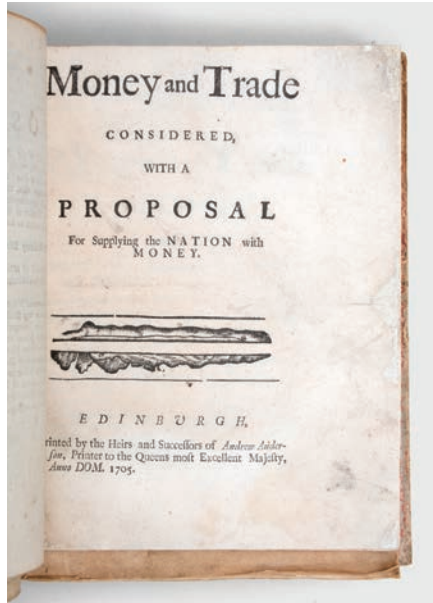

**(CARROLL, Lewis.) TENNIEL, John.** Original artwork in pencil. 1865. Tenniel's original drawing for the illustration of the Gryphon which appears on page 138 of the 1865 first edition of Carroll's *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*. **5,500,000 JPY**



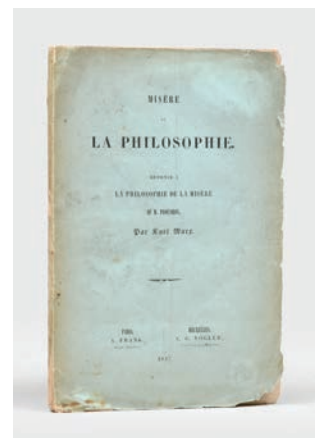
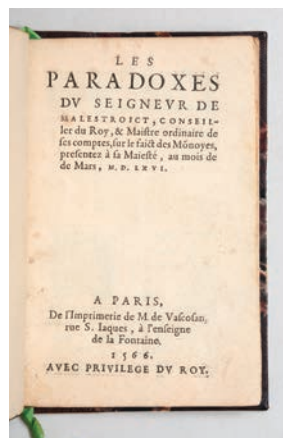
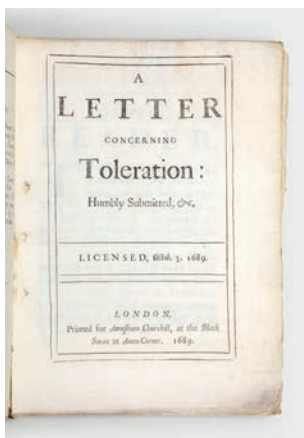


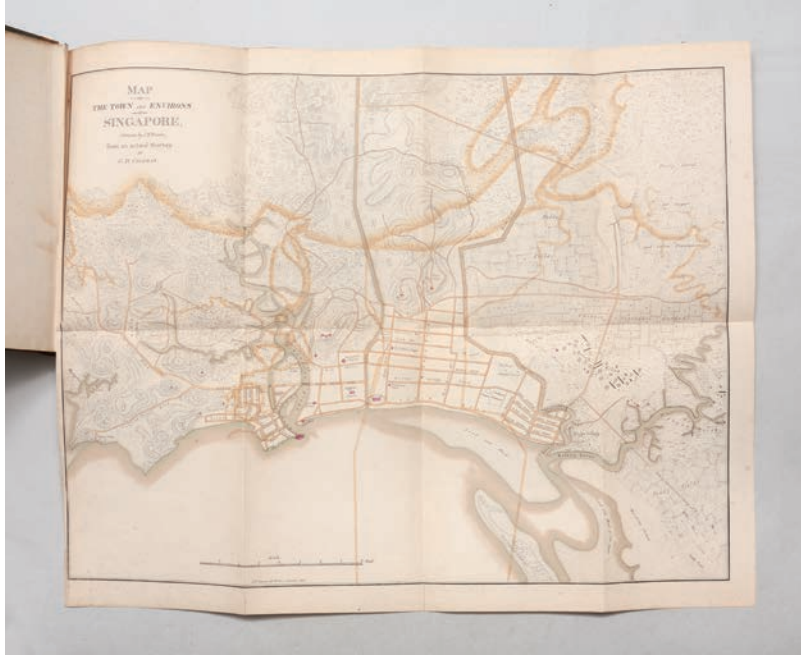
**[LAW, John.]** Money and Trade considered. *Edinburgh: Andrew Anderson, 1705.* First edition of Law's major work. 4to, bound 3rd in a pamphlet volume of 16 works on commerce and Scottish poor laws. Contemporary marbled boards, rebacked in calf. **6,500,000 JPY**

**[LOCKE, John.]** A Letter concerning Toleration. *London: Awnsham Churchill, 1689.* First edition in English of Locke's first separately published work. 4to, recent half calf and marbled boards. **3,250,000 JPY**

**MALESTROIT, Jean Cherruyt de.** Les paradoxes du seigneur de Malestroit, ... sur le fait des Mōnoyes, presentez à sa Maiesté, au mois de Mars, M.D.LXVI. *Paris: M. de Vascosan, 1566.* First edition of Malestroit's controversial treatise. Small 4to, late 19th-century half morocco and marbled boards. **5,500,000 JPY**

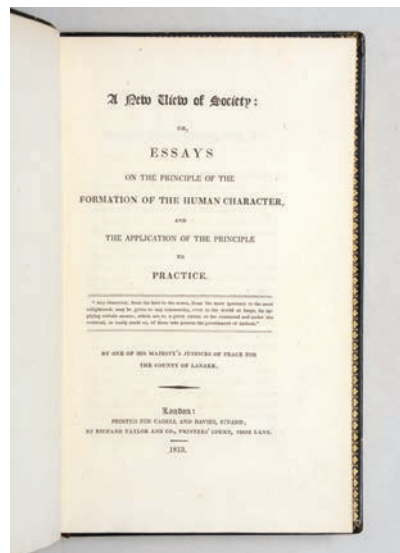
**MARX, Karl.** Misère de la philosophie. *Paris: A. Frank and C. G. Vogler, 1847.* First edition of Marx's caustic attack on Proudhon, one of 800 copies printed. Uncut and partly unopened in the original printed wrappers. **3,675,000 JPY**



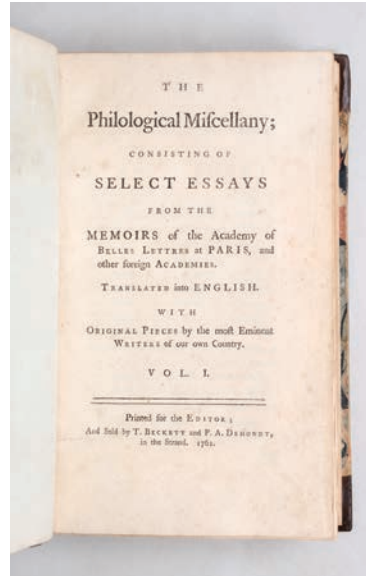
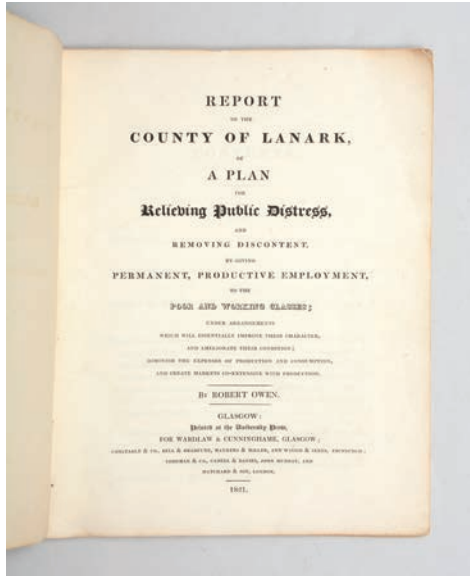


**MOOR, John Henry.** *Notices of the Indian Archipelago, and Adjacent Countries.* Singapore: printed at the Mission Press, 1837. First edition of one of the earliest books published in Singapore, comprising articles first published in the *Singapore Chronicle*, Singapore's first newspaper, between 1824 and 1834. 4to, original red cloth-backed blue paper-covered boards, expertly rebaked. **4,250,000 JPY**

**OWEN, Robert.** *A New View of Society.* London: Cadell and Davies, 1813–14. First edition, first issue of the four *Essays*, one of 40 specially bound presentation sets printed on thick paper, parts III & IV "Not published", inscribed "From the Author" on the first blank. 8vo, contemporary dark blue straight-grain morocco. **12,500,000 JPY**







**OWEN, Robert.** Report to the County of Lanark, of a Plan for Relieving Public Distress, and Removing Discontent, by giving Permanent, Productive Employment, to the Poor and Working Classes. *Glasgow: Wardlaw and Cunninghame, 1821.* First edition of the first full statement of Owen's economic ideas. 4to, contemporary grey wrappers. **4,000,000 JPY**

**SMITH, Adam.** "Considerations Concerning the First Formation of Languages." [In:] *The Philological Miscellany.* *London: Beckett and Dehondt, 1761.* Rare first edition of *The Philological Miscellany*, all published, containing the first appearance in print of Smith's "Considerations Concerning the First Formation of Languages, and the different genius of original and compounded Languages", originally part of Smith's University Lectures on Rhetoric. 8vo, contemporary half calf and marbled boards. **3,675,000 JPY**

**TYNDALE, William; John Frith; Robert Barnes.** The Whole workes of ... three worthy Martyrs, and principall teachers of this Church of England, collected and compiled in one Tome together, beyng before scattered, & now in Print here exhibited to the Church. *London: John Daye, 1573.* First edition, edited by the martyrologist John Foxe. Folio, 18th-century half calf. **3,250,000 JPY**
